Institutional Resources Mobilisation:

- Skillshare/European Union supported Programme: **Gender Based Violence (GBV): Making the Invisible Visible** project support ends on November 30, 2010. This project is run with two other collaborating partners, *Women Against Rape (WAR)* and *Bana Ba Letsatsi (BBL)* both of which are based in Maun. Emang Basadi (EB) is already seeking renewal of sponsorship and/or attracting new ones to build the necessary delivery capacity for this project to ensure its continuation. The project provides Psycho-Social Support Services to the general public. It also forms an integral part of EB services for victims and survivors of GBV, domestic violence and other forms of violence perpetrated against women, which violate their human rights.
